1st March, 2020




In these challenging times, the club members and friends of Rotary, stepped out to the plate to contribute to the local Corona Warriors via CIFOS (Citizens for Sustainability) - Sanjaynagar - where a cheque for Rs.1,00,500 was given to support common kitchen for all teams working in the RMV area during COVID relief.

Contributions of about Rs.25,000 also helped support local hospitals, designated to take care of COVID patients, with PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) kits.





Held a joint virtual meeting with 22 other clubs, with speaker Rtn. Ravi Vadlamani, RI-DN, addressing the audience on Rotary Beyond Co-VID, engaging members and the community. 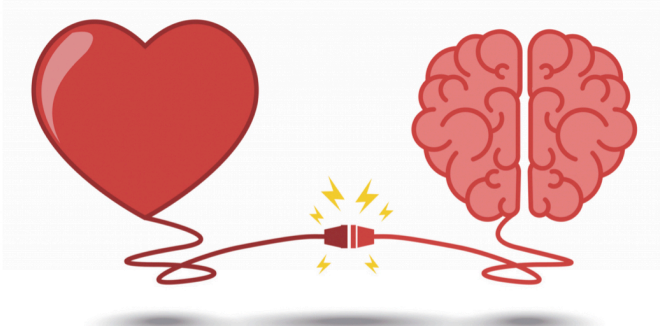
