17th Jan, 2020



Polio NID

19th Jan, 2020

As people of Action, members from Rotary Rajmahal Vilas helped conduct the Polio NID in two Primary Health Centres (PHCs) - Sanjaynagar and Munnireddy Palya - where 4055 & 8506 children were immunised respectively.

A contribution of One Lakh was made towards the End Polio Fund.



The unveiling of Billboards by was done by Area Corporator Anand of in AECS Park, Sanjaynagar, for supporting the park maintenance/upkeep along with the RWA for a period of three years.

Two 4-Way test boards, both in English and Kannada were fixed by the AECS park, surrounded by a large residential community and right opposite Sandeepani School, a well known school in the vicinity.



Flag hoisting took place with the Residents Welfare Association of AECS layout, Sanjaynagar, at the community park maintained by the club for the next 3 years.
