President's Message

Greetings,

The month of December in Rotary is Disease Prevention and Treatment. This is one of the Foundation's Areas of Focus and one that many of us would be aware of the numerous projects around the world supported by clubs and the Foundation.

Disease Prevention and Treatment.

1 in 6 people worldwide cannot pay for health care. 100 million people are pushed into poverty each year because of medical costs. 57 countries have fewer than 23 health workers for every 10,000 people. 4.3 million doctors, nurses, midwives, and other skilled caregivers are needed worldwide.

Rotary's top priority is the eradication of polio, but Rotarians take on far greater responsibilities to fight disease. They set up health camps and training facilities in undeveloped countries and in communities struggling with HIV/AIDS and malaria. They also design and build the infrastructure for doctors, nurses, governments, and partners to reach the one in six people in the world who can't afford to pay for health care.

Disease prevention and treatment takes on many forms, from supporting studies to helping immunise people to improving drinking water and the sanitation infrastructure. Rotary Rajmahal Vilas Health has been at the fore front in this focus area with multiple projects like Avoidable blindness, Covid support to the community, Providing a Paediatric Dialysis machine in one of our previous years, setting up of Eye Hospitals and participating in the Polio plus programs.


I urge all our members to reach out to your friends and family and donate generously to our projects so that we can make a difference to the community .







CLUB ACTIVITIES

Zero Hunger Project & Project Warmth | 26th December, 2021

On the 26th of Dec, to mark Christmas celebrations, lunch and dinner meals were distributed to 50+ specially- abled members at Vinyasa Trust for Disabled, Jayanagar. Our club, with contribution from Rtn. Usha, partnered with Rotary Bangalore HSR and Rotary Bangalore Central, under the Zero Hunger Project.

Under Project Warmth, further blanket distributions took place late night on the 26th of December along with Rotaractors from Rotaract RMV at the Yeswanthpur railway station.



Eye screening | December 2021

As part of the Avoidable Blindness Campaign, eye camps were held in different schools in the month of December.

On 9th of December, eye screening at Bachhehalli Government School was organised with the help of doctors from Drishti & other hospitals. Rtn Usha oversaw the camp. 154 children were screened and advice was provided to children who needed glasses and other interventions.

On 11th Dec, 75 students of GHPS Poornapura Govt. school were screened and 2 students advised for glasses and 1 referred to the hospital.

On 14th December, screenings took place at Farooqia Girls' school, RT Nagar where 85 students were screened and 20 glasses were to be provided.

At the BBMP Girls' school in Gokula, 204 students were screened and 38 were advised glasses and 6 referred to the hospital.

On 15th the camp was held at Gandhi Vidyalaya, and on16th at the Venkateshwara School, Mathikere.

Eye screening & Cataract Camp | 12th December, 2021

Under the aegis of The Avoidable Blindness Foundation, our club hosted, with support with Rotary Bengaluru HSR and Rotary Bangalore Kormangala, in partnership with the BBMP and camp managed by Rangalakshmi Netralaya, conducted a free eye screening and cataract camp at Sanajaynagar UPHC. 105 people were screened, 20 pairs of spectacles given, with 15 surgeries planned.

The surgeries took place on the 18th of December, with the able assistance of Rtn. Usha and Sundar Prakash who helped follow up. We thank Rtn. Dr Venkat of Rangalalshmi Hospital for performing the surgeries. Ex Corporator Anand and RCC Geddalahalli President Indrahas Gowda for managing the logistics, and to CSR partner, iValue for sponsoring the surgeries and Rotary Koramangala and Rotary HSR for their support. 6 cataract surgeries and one injection of anti VEGF were given, at Rangalakshmi Netralaya hospital.

Vaccination Drive support at Sanjaynagar PHC | November 2021



I wish I were a flower in bloom, which removes everyone's gloom.


I wish I were a butterfly, which loves flowers and the clear blue sky.
