







# Service Projects





We had a talk on the New Age Investment Options Post-Covid Environment by Sousthav Chakrabarty of Siply, a Tech-enabled Micro-savings platform. He helps people inculcate a habit of saving, using technology, gamification, and a planning-first approach. His talk covered the areas of venture debt investing (earning fixed income of 12-15% p.a. with relatively lower risk), algorithmic based futures investing strategy (high returns with ability to define and control risk), private equity and convertible debentures investments (high returns with high risk, and high returns with downside protection), and general portfolio management services.





## Service Project: Blood Donation Drive 14th November, 2020

Donating blood is one the greatest ways to help humankind. A Blood bank drive was organised by Rotary Bangalore - Rajmahal Vilas, Centennial & Yelahanka clubs, with association with the Bangalore Medical Services Trust - A Rotary Bangalore and TTK initiative, with all the safety measures in place. Eight Rotarians, 2 Ann's, 2 annettes, 5 rotractors participated in the drive and collected 20 units of blood that went to the Rotary TTK blood bank.







## **Financial Discipline**


