The annual District Governor's official visit, held at the DG's office, went off successfully. Secretary Hedge gave a wonderful summary of our club's performance which was heartily praised by the DG. For excellence in Vocational Service, Prof. N.J. Rao, faculty at IISC, Alopa Gupa, special educator and Ms. Sunita V.P., medical pathologist, were facilitated.

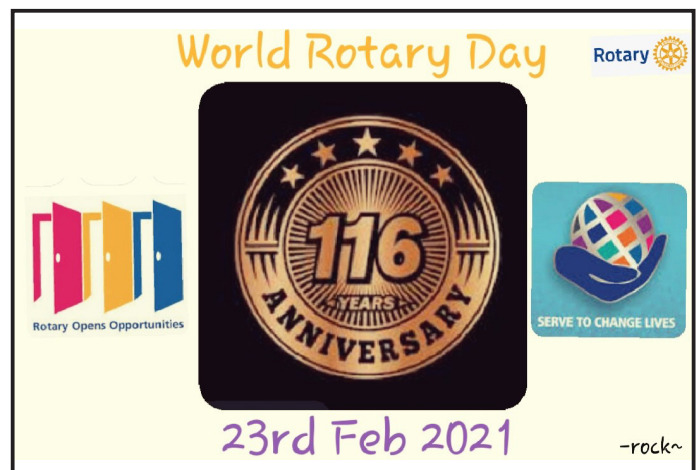
Animal Welfare
