### **Making Learning Fun and Enjoyable for all Students**

#### "The work of education is divided between the teacher and the environment." ~ Maria Montessori

Keeping students engaged and motivated can be a challenge, even for the best teachers. It's easy to teach the same lessons year after year simply because they have worked in the past, without giving much thought to students' current interest level. But even the strongest curriculum still needs some variety once in a while to make learning fun.

Here are few strategies that can assist teachers and students with this process to make learning fun.

Ø Engage all kinds of intelligences – Educators need to remember that all students are not capable of learning via the same medium. Once teachers have uncovered the learning styles of their students for e.g. visual, audio or kinesthetics learners they can create hands-on activities which encourages the students to learn and create an enjoyable learning experience.

Ø Encourage Interaction - When students are learning, it can be much more fun and engaging for them

to work with a classmate. Look for ways for students to work with each other in the classroom. Think-pair-share activities are a great method.

Ø Host Some Friendly Competition - - Whenever you can add some movement to a lesson, make it happen — it'll make things livelier and more exciting for everyone. Students have fun playing games. And sometimes, they don't even realize that they're learning because a game is so amusing!


